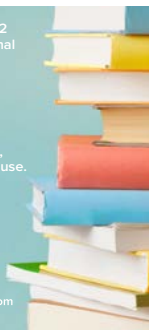

Important Information

LINEUP: Entertainers and schedules are subject to change without notice.

TICKETS: All sales are final. No refunds or rain checks for any reason. Event is held rain or shine.

DRESS CODE: All clothing shall be appropriate for a family event. Please do NOT wear clothing with messages with double meaning or advertisement for adult-themed products. Shoes and shirts are required.

WEATHER: Local emergency services will inform us if severe weather is approaching. Please listen to stage announcements. Rain ponchos are recommended instead of umbrellas. If you do bring umbrellas, please be courteous of those around you. Umbrellas should NOT be used inside the concert seating areas during performances. Larger canopy-style umbrellas (sport-brellas) will be allowed beyond the chair area, furthest away from the main stage. Rain ponchos and sunscreen will be available for purchase at the OneFest merchandise area.

SECURITY: There is 24-hour security on the grounds. Please report any suspicious activities to onsite security. Call 911 for all emergencies.

PARKING HOURS: Parking lots will be open 3:00pm Friday, 7:00am Saturday, and 9:00am Sunday until 2-hours after end of last show. Daily parking cost is \$5 cash only on Friday and Saturday, and FREE on Sunday.

FESTIVAL GROUNDS HOURS: Security check points into the festival grounds will be open 4:00pm Friday and 8:00am Saturday until 1-hour after end of last show on both Friday and Saturday.

EARLY ENTRY PASS: This pass provides early access into the grounds, beginning at 8:00am Saturday ONLY. This will be your best opportunity to pre-place your own lawn chair

closer to the main stage. This pass is general seating, first come, first choice. It is NOT a reserved (assigned) seat or a reserved section. This pass simply allows you to enter 1-hour early before everybody else. Passes are limited availability and subject to selling out. Early entry pass holders will still need to purchase a general admission ticket.

PHOTOS: Personal cameras and camera phones are allowed – please take photos and share them. Professional photo camera equipment including detachable lenses 6-inches and longer, tripods, monopods, selfie sticks, drones, etc. are strictly prohibited. Unauthorized video cameras will NOT be allowed. By attending this event, you agree to the release of your image for OneFest's promotional purposes.

LAWN CHAIRS: You may bring your own lawn chairs to use in both the main stage and side stage concert seating areas. All seating areas are general seating first come, first choice. Chairs are NOT permitted in the bleachers or standing only areas.

GRANDSTAND BLEACHER SEATING: Consider bringing your own stadium seats, cushions, and blankets to use in the bleachers. Cushion rentals will NOT be available.

CARRY-IN FOOD, DRINKS, BAGS: Sorry, carry-in food and beverages are NOT allowed inside the festival grounds. We kindly ask that you consume any food items in the parking lots or camping areas. You may carry-in empty water bottles to refill inside the festival grounds. Coolers are NOT allowed. Bags and backpacks are allowed inside the festival grounds, but please allow our security teams to search your bags and other carry-in items,

when requested, upon entering the festival grounds.

LOST & FOUND: The lost and found is located in the main office on the grounds during the event. After the event, items will be taken to the OneFest mailing address where they will be held for 30 days following the event. You may email info@one-fest.com to locate your items. OneFest is NOT responsible for lost, stolen, or forgotten items.

PETS: Except for Service Animals, pets are NOT permitted on the festival grounds including the parking lots. Pets are allowed in the camping area following Fair Hill Campground policy.

MEET AND GREETs: Pre-purchased Meet and Greet's will be available for pickup in-person at the main office on the grounds. Any extra passes will be made available for purchase in-person at the main office on Friday and Saturday.

SMOKING: Use of tobacco products is allowed on the grounds, but please be courteous of those around you. Smoking cigarettes inside buildings or near building entrances is strictly prohibited. Smoking is NOT allowed inside the concert seating areas during performances. Electronic cigarettes (e-cigs) and vaping supplies are NOT allowed.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: Alcohol, illegal drugs, dangerous weapons, toy weapons, fireworks, noisemakers, laser pointers, etc. will be confiscated and will NOT be returned. Violators may be removed from the grounds without any refund. Illegal activities will be reported to local authorities. Do NOT bring: bicycles, skateboards, hover boards, in-line skates.


